How to Use the Colorado Legal Services Website

How to Begin

- Type www.ColoradoLegalServices.org into your browser, and then click on the same address.
- Click on one of the legal areas listed, as an example Employment.
- On that page, click on your topic of interest, for example Wage Claims.
- Enter your zip code, city or county.

1 Self Help Legal Information

- Follow 'How to Begin' above, then click on the 'Self Help Legal Info' tab. You will see a list of legal resources.
- Click on a resource which will open in a new browser. You can click on links in the resource to access more information. Select Control (Ctrl) and P on your keyboard to print the resource.
- Click on the small 'x' on the top right corner of the page to close the resource.

2 Where to Find Legal Assistance

- Follow 'How to Begin' above, then click on the 'Where to Find Legal Help' tab. You will see a list of offices that may be able to help you with your problem.
- Click on the office name to view office hours, phone number, address and more.

3 What about the Courts

- Follow 'How to Begin' above, then click on the 'What about the Courts' tab. These resources will teach you about the courts, including where they are located, what forms you might need, what the court fees are and more.

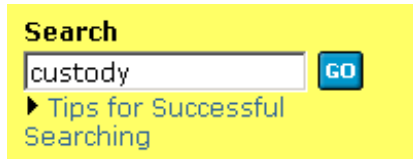
4 Where to Get Other Help

- Follow 'How to Begin' above, then click on the 'Where to Get Other Help' tab. This part of the site has lists of agencies and organizations that can help beyond your legal issue.
