CIVIL PROTECTION ORDER CLINIC

If you are a victim of domestic violence, stalking or sexual assault and need assistance with understanding the civil protection order process and filling out the paperwork, please come to the Civil Protection Order Clinic offered by Family Tree Women In Crisis. The filing process will take 2-3 hours.

When: Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

In addition to assistance with civil protection order paperwork, advocates may also provide accompaniment to the clerk of the court, the judges' clerks, the temporary hearing and the Sheriff's Department for service. If a temporary civil protection order is granted, a Legal Advocate may also provide preparation and accompaniment for the permanent protection order hearing.
